What should I bring?

- * Wear fleece, wool, or nylon. Avoid cotton.
- * Water shoes, river shoes, or sneakers. No flip-flops.
- * Bring a waterbottle, sunglasses, sun screen and a waterproof camera.
- * Swimsuits, a hat, and dry clothes for tubing trips.

What Do You Provide For Your Guests?

- * All equipment, including boats, paddles, life vests, tubes, and helmets when needed.
- * Drinks, snacks and meals depending on trip length.
- * Professional Registered Master Maine Guide.
- * Shuttle Service.

Are There Any Age Requirements?

- * Most of our trips are suitable for the entire family. There is an age requirement of 15 for a few of the tubing trips.
